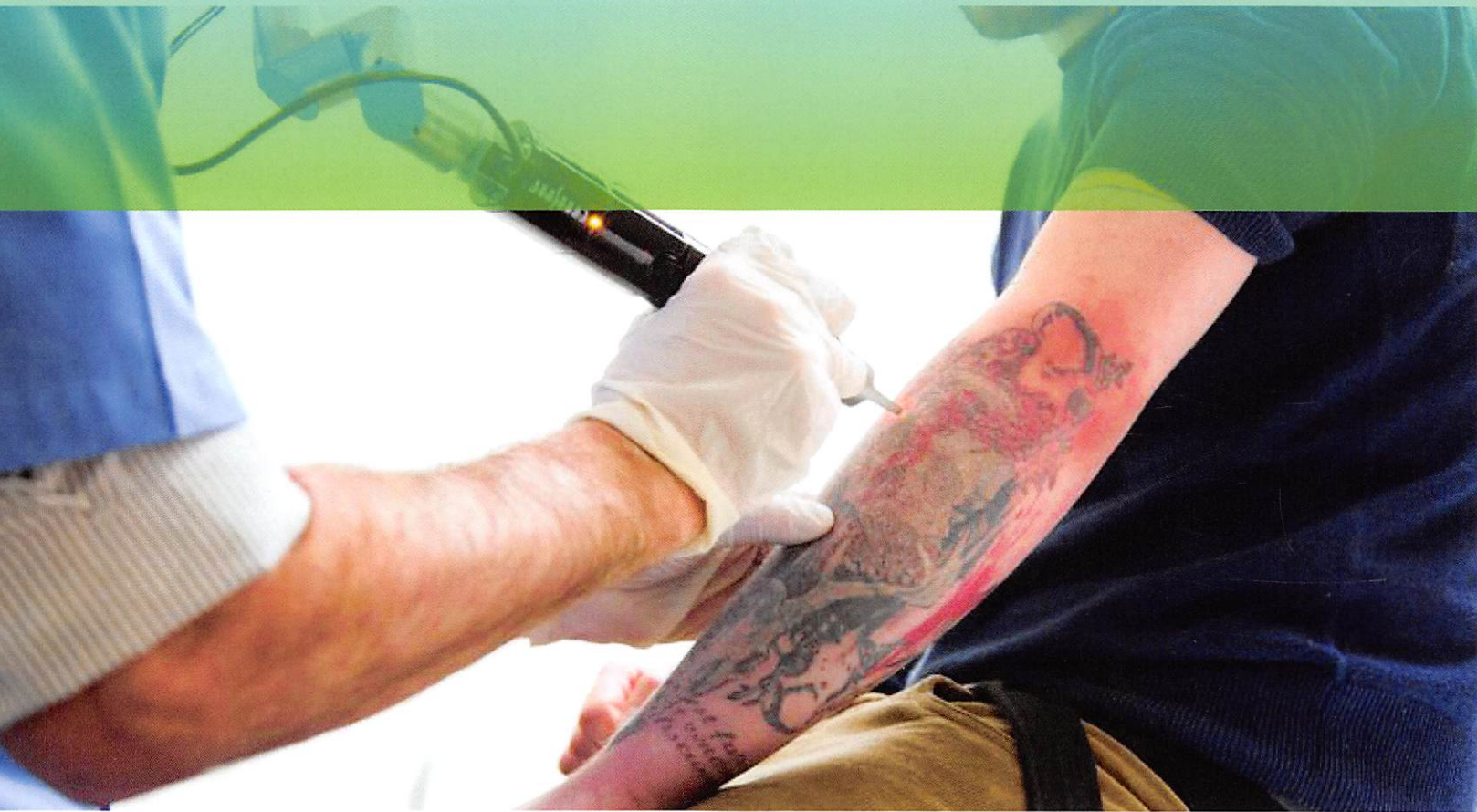

About

The Tattoo Removal Program has been a tool for change since 1996. This program aims to help those who are transitioning out of gang involvement, as well as survivors of both domestic abuse and human trafficking. Participants seek to erase marks from their past to brighten their future.

Who We Serve

- Participants 10 years and older
- Must be attending school, or currently working
- Domestic abuse and human trafficking survivors
- Reformed gang members
- Participants from diverse communities

Participant Requirements

- Must perform 20-plus hours of community service
- Be willing to regularly meet with a program sponsor
- Maintain a positive lifestyle

Cynosure Medlite C6 Laser



The Tattoo Removal Program owns a Cynosure Medlite C6 Laser. This laser works by targeting pigment colors in the skin's dermis, the layer of the skin between the epidermis and subcutaneous tissues. Light beams radiated by the laser are absorbed by tattoo pigments, which then fragment. The body then absorbs and eliminates the pigment fragments, permanently removing the tattoo ink.

Looking For:

RNs, NPs, PAs, MDs, and those who have tattoo removal experience.

Time Commitment:

Minimum time commitment is 1 session (or 6 hours) per year.

Responsibilities:

Medical professionals will be utilizing the Cynosure Medlite C6 Laser for the tattoo removal process.

Location:

Sessions will be held at a location in Redwood City, CA.

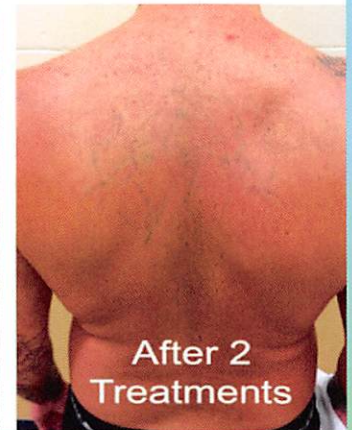
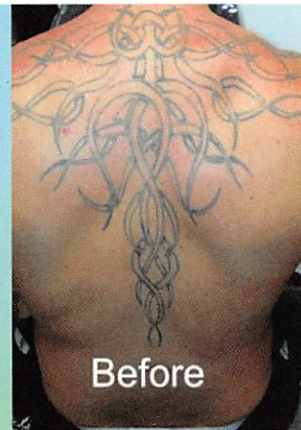
